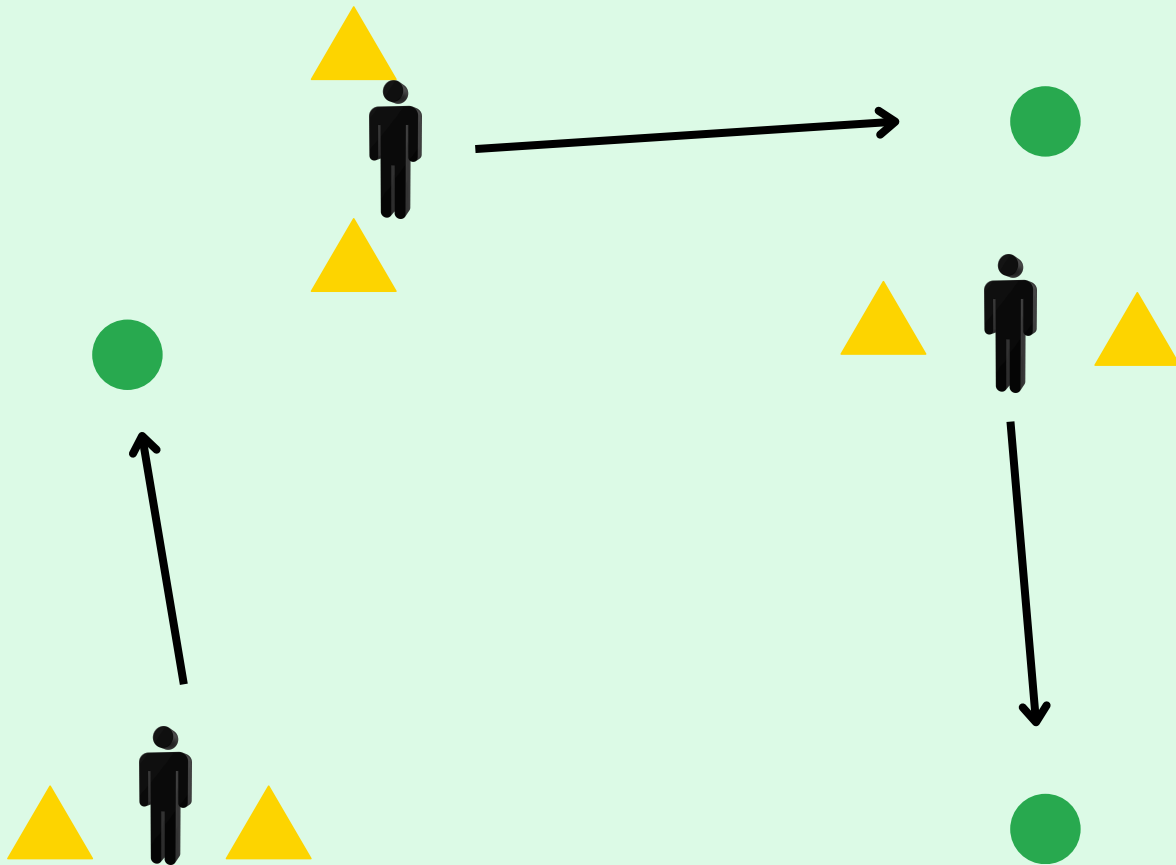


HORSE Putting



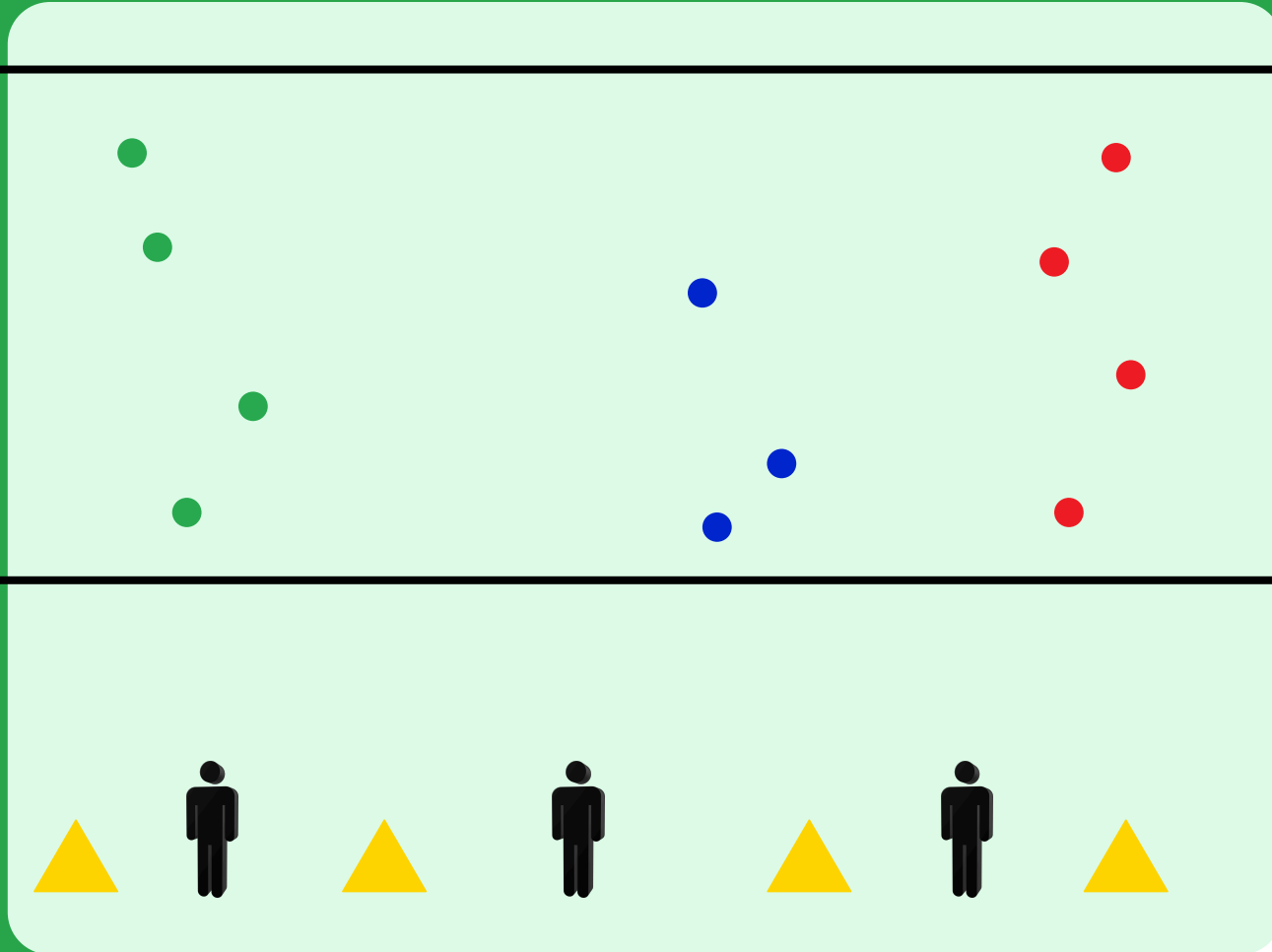
Activity Set-up and Description

HORSE can be set up with different putts around one hole, or as a golf course. There are multiple ways to play, for example: Farthest from the hole gets a letter or highest score on a hole gets a letter. For more advanced participants, letters are only earned when a player misses a putt that their competitor makes.

Materials

Cones
Golf Balls

Leap Frog Chipping



Activity Set-up and Description

Using tape, rope, or string, create a space to chip within. The idea is to have the first playing partner chip as short as possible while still being in the “chipping zone”. Their partner must chip past their partners ball for it to count. The goal is to get as many of your team’s golf balls in the chipping zone.

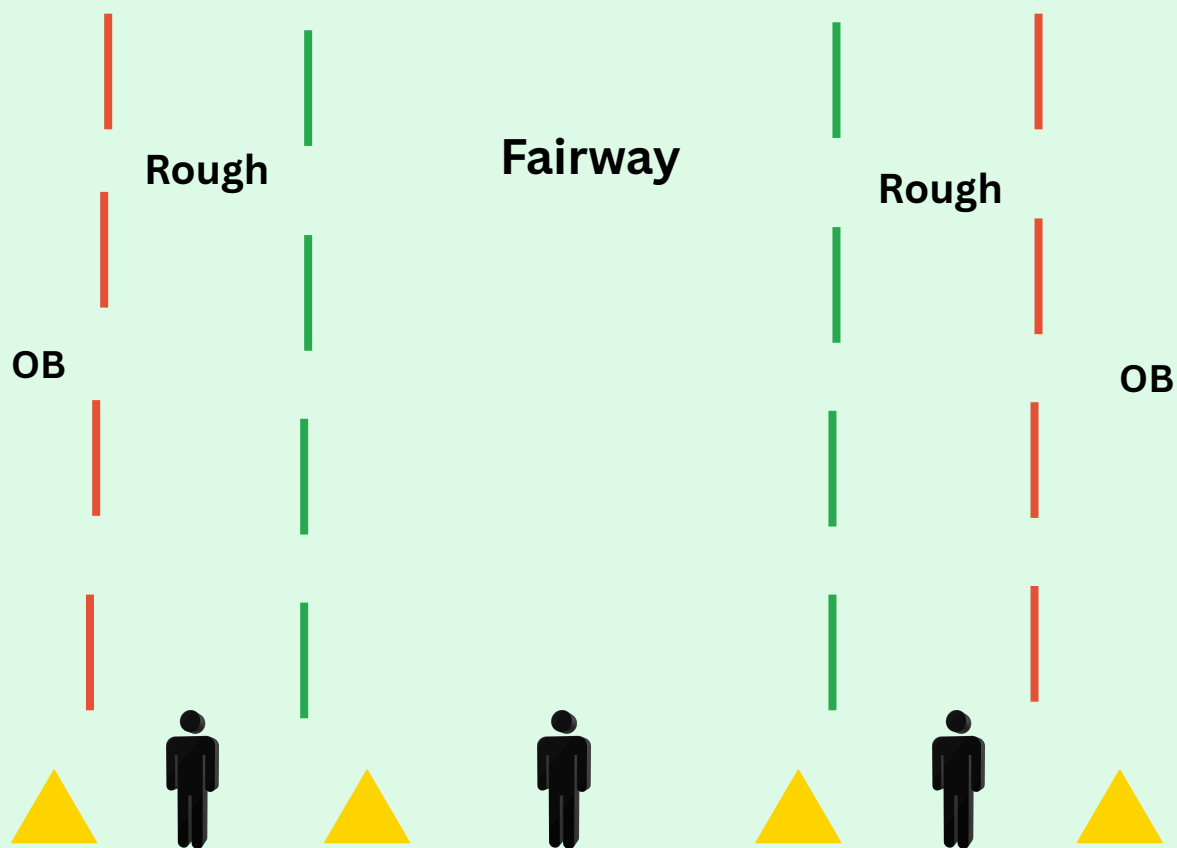
Materials

- Cones
- Flagging tape
- Tees
- Colored golf balls

Fairway Bound

Activity Set-up and Description

This activity will help participants improve their ability to hit the golf ball into a fairway. This will also serve as a way to introduce that part of the golf course to new participants. Coaches can make the fairway wider or narrower to make it more challenging. You can also add another inner layer as the fairway and the outer layer can be OB. Between the two can be the rough and points can be awarded for fairway 5 points vs rough 3 points)



Materials

- Cones
- Flagging tape
- Tees
- Colored golf balls
